

North Point Recreation Area

North Point Bicycle/Hiking Trail

Type of trail: Hiking, bicycling, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing

Trail surface: Asphalt and gravel

Wheelchair accessible: Yes, a portion is paved

Rated: Easy, mostly flat with a few moderate grades

Fee required: Park Entrance License

Length of trail in miles: Two miles total, approximately one mile of asphalt and one mile of gravel

Location of the trailhead: North Point Entrance Station

Facilities along the trail: Water, comfort stations, vault toilets, swimming beach, picnic shelters, volleyball, playgrounds, parking lots, boat ramps
