


Documented Mortalities

Human-caused Lion Mortalities (Black Hills)





- Mortality density of 5-8/1000 sq. km = stable (WYGF)
- Stable threshold established in western lion populations

2015/16 Harvest Statistics

SOUTH DAKOTA Game, Fish & Parks

Black Hills

- 49% of licensed hunters spent time hunting lions
- Black Hills Success per active hunter = 2.3%

Custer State Park

- 52% of licensed hunters spent time hunting lions
 - 36% for boot hunters, 100% for hunters using hounds
- Harvested 1 female and 5 males
- Success per active hunter
 - 50% (with hounds), 0% (boot)

Harvest per unit effort







Figure 1: Harvest per unit effort for Black Hills seasons, 2009 to 2016 (excludes CSP)

Harvest Composition

Adult Female Harvest %



- Some Western States research suggests lion populations begin to decline when adult females comprise > 25% of the harvest
- SD 2016 adult female harvest = 26%



DNA Sampling - Biopsy Darting



3 houndsman teams

Sampling period Nov 23- Dec 24, 2015

 6 sampling units to ensure all areas sampled and represented


- 56 DNA samples collected (31 in 2014)
 - 32 females, 22 males, 2 unknown
 - 37 adults, 14 subadults, 5 kittens
 - DNA sent to USFS Genetics Lab in Montana

Biopsy Darting Catch per unit effort

DNA Sampling Results - 2015





- Survey sampling distribution:
 - Area 1 = 7 Area 4 = 12
 - Area 2 = 14 Area 5 = 5
 - Area 3 = 16 Area 6 = 2
- 56 DNA samples collected via biopsy darting
 - 7 duplicates, 49 individual lions
 - 5 kittens biopsied = 44 samples
- 9 active radio collared lions
 - 3 sampled in biopsy darting sampling; 6 collar samples
- 50 total individuals with DNA in mark/recapture analyses




- Using Mark-Recapture Modified Lincoln-Petersen analyses
- Using 50 available DNA marked individual lions
- Estimate of adults and subadults

2016 and 2017 Lion Seasons



Most survey trend data suggest downward to stable lion population

Black Hills

- Reduced annual <u>harvest limits</u>:
 - Total reduce from 75 to 60
 - Female reduce from 50 to 40

CSP

- Made hunting intervals for boot and hound hunters equal (14 days)
- Hound hunting allowed permits:
 - Reduced from 4 to 3 access permits/hunting interval
 - Total permits = 12 (16 in 2015)
- No Hound hunting allowed permits:
 - Reduced from 30 to 15 access permits/hunting interval
 - Reduced from 4 to 3 hunting intervals
 - Total permits = 45 (120 in 2015)
